If you're looking for a new creative challenge...if you enjoy collaborative projects...if you like working with and getting to know new people with different artistic interests...we are looking for YOU. Come work with a dynamic team of graduate students from across the visual and performing arts disciplines who are all invested in offering a dynamic workshop focused on re-imagining undergraduate arts education with a focus on collaboration and interdisciplinarity.

In the professional arts realm, disciplinary boundaries continue to blur and interdisciplinary collaboration is on the rise. Day 3 [Saturday, August 18, 9am-9pm]

work on projects and have feedback sessions with facilitators, enjoy free breakfast and lunch, exhibit works-in-progress for friends and family, enjoy a closing reception
